Description: this slide shows a skeleton for presenting research in written and oral format (note that this slide has more than seven bullets – tables and unbreakable entities are exceptions to the rule of maximum seven bullets); typically, the best among the existing solutions is compared with different ideas of the authors. Explanation: if followed, this structure will ensure that essential elements of the topic are included in the presentation in a logical manner. Implication: research given in this format will be conveyed effectively and will not be lost to poor presentation.
